Sacramento County Department of Waste Management & Recycling has two locations where you can recycle these materials FREE

FREE DROP OFF ITEMS *Load must only contain free items.

The following items are accepted for free* at Kiefer Landfill and the North Area Recovery Station for recycling.

Small Household Corded Items: coffee makers, microwaves, toasters/toaster ovens, telephones, curling irons/hair dryers, vacuums



Small Household Corded Items also include: Blenders, Food Processors, Electric Shavers, Box Fans, Portable Heaters

Small Power Tools: drills, grinders, routers, sanders, power saws



Large Appliances: refrigerator, stoves/ovens, washers/dryers, dishwashers (Residents may drop off up to two per day)



Electronics: cellphones/PDAs/Devices with digital screens-laptops, computer mice, printers/fax machines, wires, digital cameras, DVD Players, keyboards, TVs, computers, gaming consoles, copiers



Electronics also include: Tablet PCs, All-in-one Desktops, Servers, Loose Circuit Boards and Cards, Routers and Modems, DVRs and Cable Boxes, CD and DVD Drives and Hard Drives, Stereos, Zip Drives

Bulky Items: tires - Passenger Vehicle/Light Truck (limit 4 per day), child car/booster seat, mattresses/Box Springs, clean metals

Only Accepted at Kiefer Landfill: bricks, concrete (no rebar and no larger than 36 inches)
