Sharps Disposal in Sacramento County



Each year, 8 million people in the United States use more than 3 billion needles, syringes and lancets - also called sharps - to manage medical conditions at home.

Improper disposal methods may result in community exposure to the sharps. People at the greatest risk of being stuck by used sharps include garbage and sewer treatment workers, janitors and housekeepers, and children.

Due to the many hazards that unsafe disposal practices present, the California Health and Safety Code now prohibits anyone from knowingly placing home generated sharps waste in garbage, recycling, and green waste containers.

How to Package Your Sharps for Disposal

Sharps should be placed in containers specifically rated for disposal of sharps, which can be purchased at any pharmacy.
