...TOSS THEM IN THE ORGANICS CART WITH YARD TRIMMINGS - EASY!

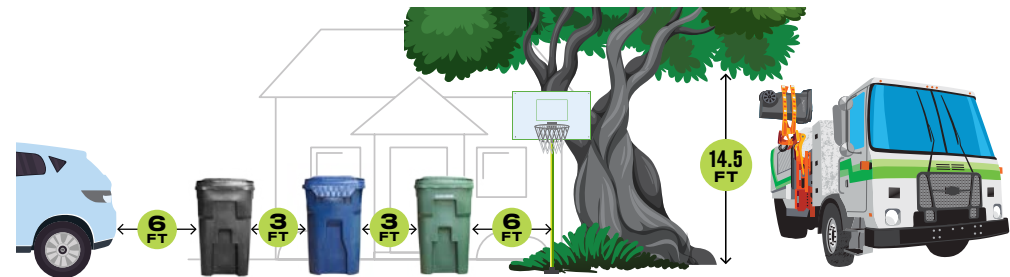

CART SET-OUT

To receive service:

- **Carts at the curb by 6 a.m.**, including holidays, with handle facing your residence. Do not block sidewalks.
- **Carts need their space.** Place carts –
 - **3 feet** from other carts.
 - **6 feet** from cars, mailboxes, basketball hoops, and other objects.
 - **14.5 feet** of overhead clearance from tree limbs, utility wires, or awnings to empty cart into collection truck.



- Lids must be **closed**.
 - Do not pack heavy/bulky items.
 - Items must fall freely.
 - No items next to or on top of cart.
- Do not pile leaves in street. Put loose in Organics cart.
- Return carts to your property after service per Sacramento County Code 12.12.035.

BULKY WASTE PICKUP

ONE PICKUP EVERY 12 MONTHS IS INCLUDED IN YOUR RATE. ADDITIONAL PICKUPS ARE AVAILABLE FOR A FEE.



Bulky waste is limited to 5 cubic yards/8'x4'x4', i.e., pickup truck bed loaded to the top of cab. Additional bulky waste material, subject to added fees. Keep bulky waste 6 feet from objects.

ACCEPTED FOR PICKUP:

- ✓ Items too large for Garbage cart (Furniture, mattresses, etc.)
- ✓ Clean lumber/tree/shrub trimmings* and pipes (max. 4" width, 5' long)
- ✓ Appliances*
- ✓ E-waste* (TVs/computers/cell phones, etc.)
- ✓ Tires* (rims OK; 4 max.)
- ✓ Fluorescent tubes* (4 feet or less)

*Place these items to one side of your garbage material.

ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED:

- ✗ No waste generated from a business
- ✗ No heavy material (rocks, dirt, tree stumps, etc.)
- ✗ No glass panes/mirrors/shower doors
- ✗ No other household hazardous waste (batteries, chemicals, oil, paint, propane tanks, etc.)
- ✗ No treated wood (fence posts, railroad ties, decking, etc.)
- ✗ No liquids

USED OIL AND USED FILTERS PICKUP

USED MOTOR OIL/ FILTERS, AND COOKING OIL COLLECTED WEEKLY ON YOUR SERVICE DAY, AT CURB BY 6 A.M.



- Place used oil in rigid or semi-rigid plastic containers with screw-top lids (no pop-top lids); or,
- Reuse the original screw-top plastic oil containers; and
- Securely tape all lids.
- Max container size is up to a 5-quart.
- Limited to three (3) containers per collection.
- Oil filters must be drained and placed in a sealed plastic bag.
- Place used motor oil, used oil filters, and cooking oil at the curb **3 feet** from carts.

TDD: **7-1-1** hearing/speech impaired

Use: **Sac County 311 Connect Mobile App** to send a photo that gives GPS location and/or violator information. A tip that leads to an administrative civil penalty, citation, or arrest may be eligible for a **\$1,000** reward.

TAKE IT TO A LOCAL DROP-OFF LOCATION IN SACRAMENTO COUNTY. IT'S EASY AND FREE.



DO NOT PUT HHW IN ANY CART

Auto & household batteries



Paint & paint thinners



Household cleaners, fertilizer/pesticides



Brake/transmission fluid & antifreeze



Home-generated needles & syringes
(please seal in hard plastic or metal containers)



Fluorescent tubes & bulbs

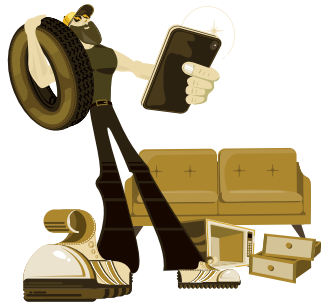
OLIVIA ORGANICS

- Separates Organics such as food scraps, food-soiled paper, and yard trimmings from garbage.
- Puts them in the Organics cart to make beneficial compost.
- Helps reduce methane emissions.
- Saves landfill space.



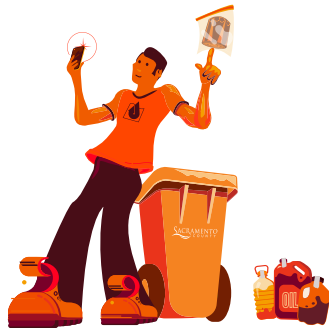
ROBBIE RECYCLE

- Recycles right. Puts empty and dry recyclables loose in the Recycling cart. Does not bag recyclables.
- Recycles items like metal cans, flattened cardboard, paper, plastic water bottles, yogurt containers and hard plastics.



BULKY BEN

- Reduces landfill waste by reusing, recycling or donating usable bulky items.
- Schedules a Bulky Waste Pickup appointment to get rid of broken-down items.



OSCAR OIL

- Recycles used motor oil and used cooking oil right!
- Never puts oil/filters in any cart, or pours on the ground or down storm drains.
- Follows curbside collection set out requirements.



GABBY GARBAGE

- Rethinks waste and what is garbage as items in your Garbage cart are buried in the landfill!
- When possible, consider re-purposing, recycling, and donating items before tossing them in the Garbage cart.



HAZEL HAZ-WASTE

- Wants to help residents properly dispose of unused household hazardous waste!
- Brings household hazardous waste (HHW) to local HHW drop-off facilities for proper disposal. It's easy and free!
