Tips:

1. Plan ahead! Make a list & only buy what you need.
2. Store or preserve your leftovers (e.g., freeze slices of turkey or pie for another time).
3. Place food-scraps & food-soiled paper in a compostable or clear plastic bag and take to the organic's container.
