Food scraps



Fruits & vegetables

Food-soiled paper and napkins



Plant material, clean wood scraps: wooden coffee stir sticks, chopsticks, toothpicks

⊘ No coated paper or cartons



⊘ No glass



⊘ No plastics



⊘ No liquids



⊘ No treated, painted, stained, oiled wood



⊘ No pet waste

## WHAT TO PUT IN THE RECYCLING CONTAINER



Glass bottles & jars



Clean paper, flattened cardboard & paperboard



Metal cans



Plastic bottles & containers

⊘ No plastic bags or plastic wrap, Styrofoam™



⊘ No propane tanks, paint, batteries, needles



⊘ No cords, chains, clothes hangers, or other tangles



⊘ No coated paper or cartons



⊘ No clothing, shoes, blankets



⊘ No organics



⊘ No liquids

# GARBAGE

## WHAT TO PUT IN THE GARBAGE CONTAINER



Household garbage



Plastic bags, utensils, film plastics



Coated paper & cartons



Chip bags & candy wrappers



Styrofoam™, compostable plastic



Cords, chains, clothes hangers, or other tangles



Clothing, shoes, blankets



Pet waste, diapers

### ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED



⊘ No organics



⊘ No recyclables (including no cardboard)



⊘ No liquids



⊘ No e-waste



⊘ No furniture or bulky items



⊘ No hot ashes, coals, fireworks



⊘ No hazardous waste
